## Overall Commentary

The Spheria Global Opportunities Fund returned 1.4% (after fees) during the month of April, outperforming the MSCI World Small Cap Index by 0.2%.

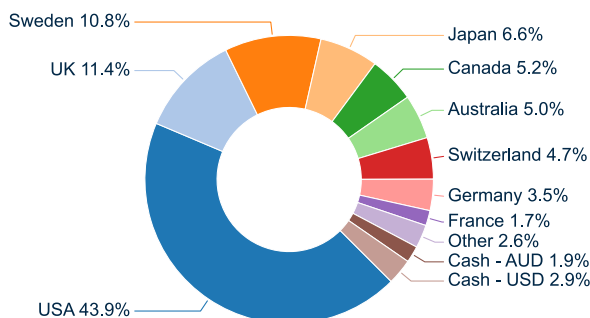
The top performers for the month were Fielmann (FIE GR), Mader Group (MAD AU), and Sonos (SONO US). Fielmann and Mader reported strong quarterly results, whilst Sonos is now up more than 50% from its lows of late last calendar year.

The major detractors for the month were Napco (NSSC US), GoPro (GPRO US) and BML Inc (4694 JP) on minimal news flow.

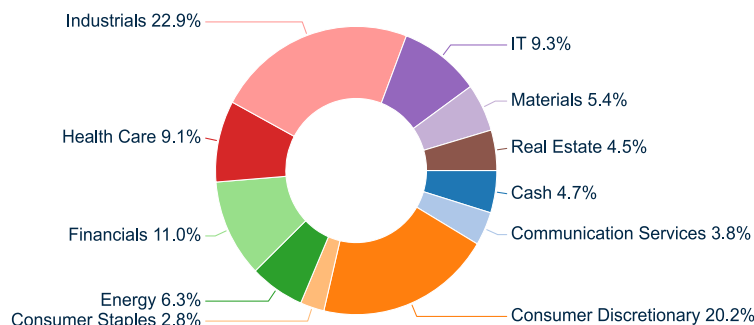
